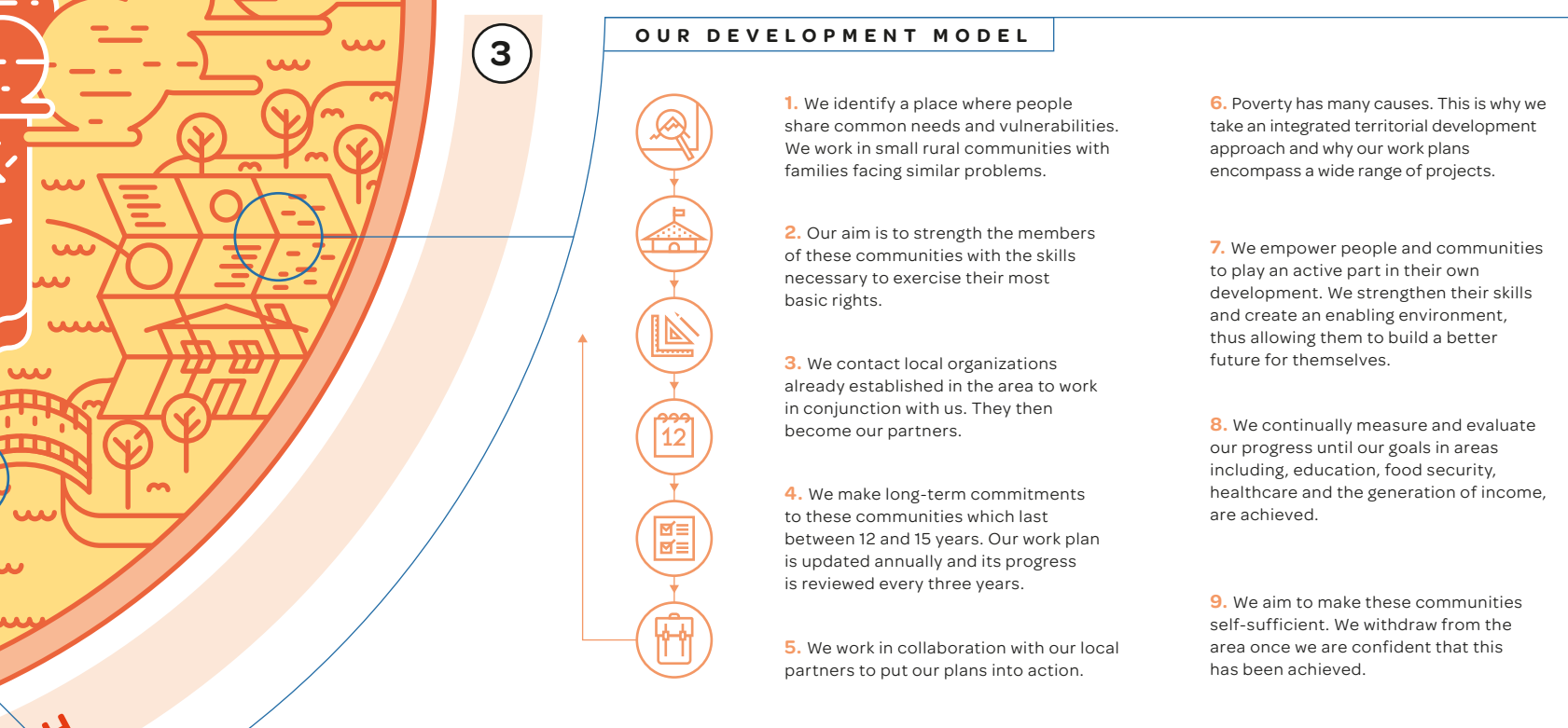
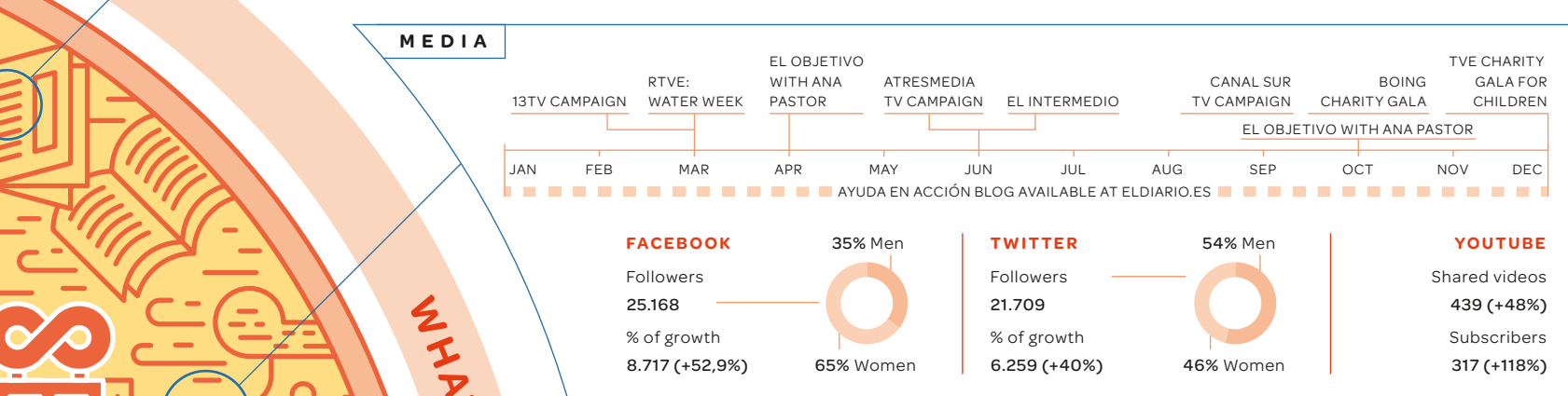
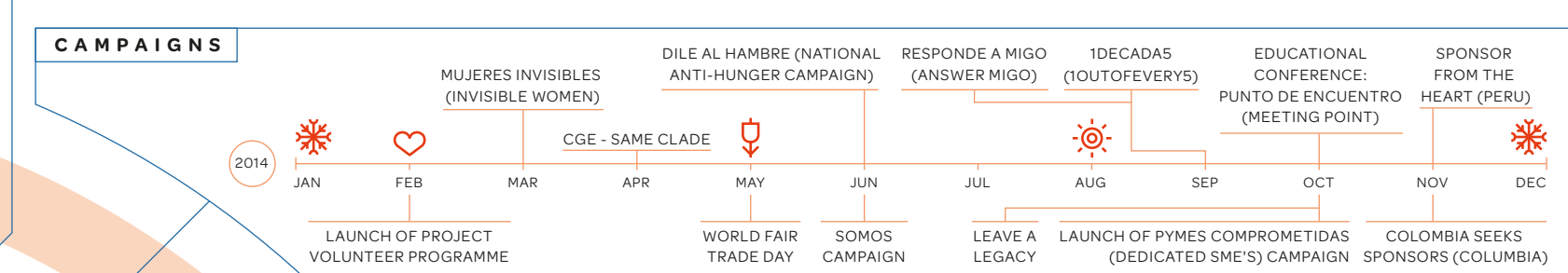
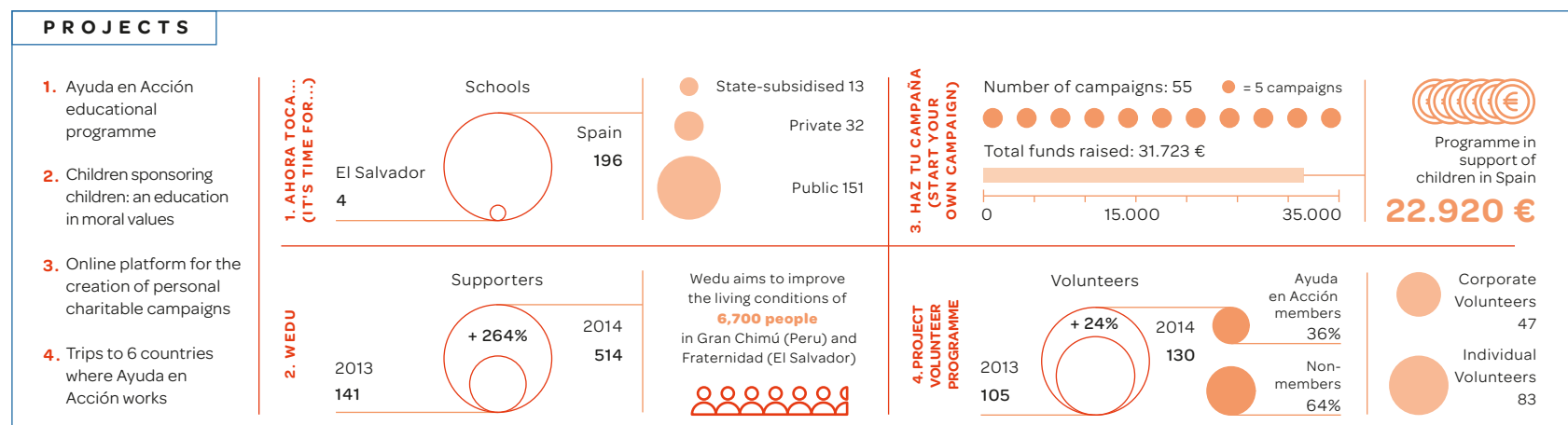
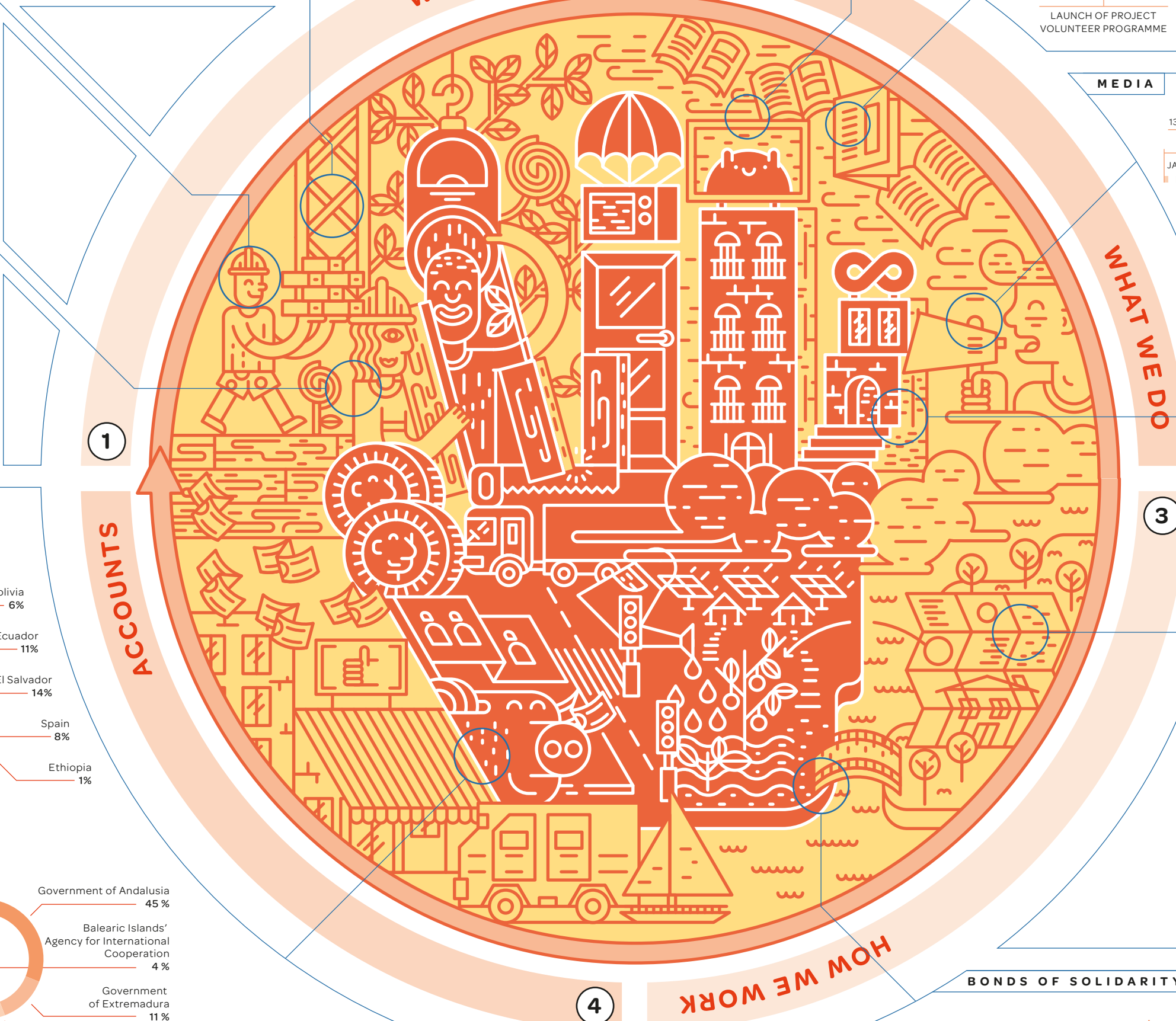
TRANSPARENCY

In order to eradicate poverty and inequality we combine the efforts and solidarity of various stakeholders: civil society, corporations, and public administrations.

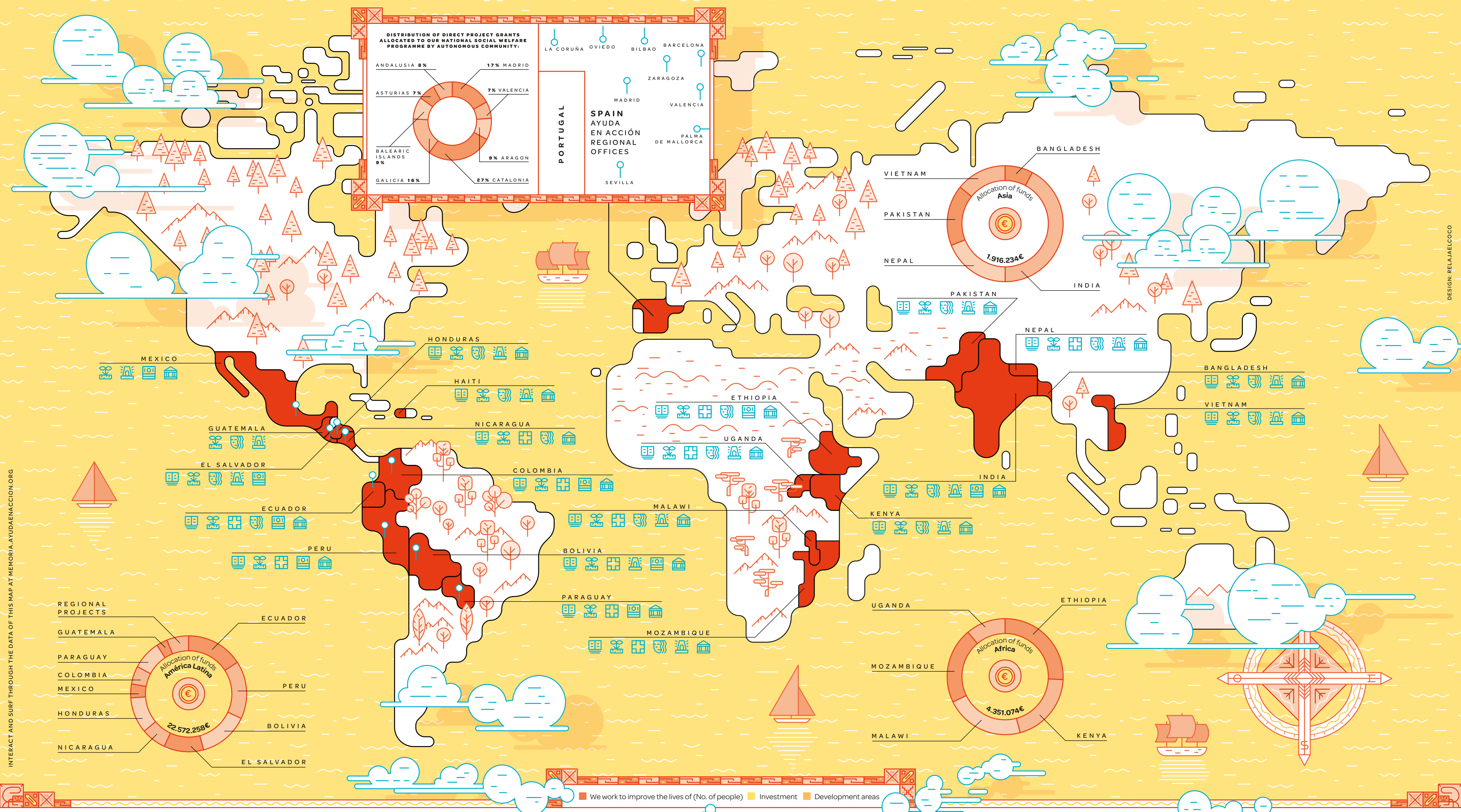
Through what we call bonds of solidarity, we build bridges between those who contribute and those in need, which enables both parties to get to learn more about each other and the respective environments in which they live.

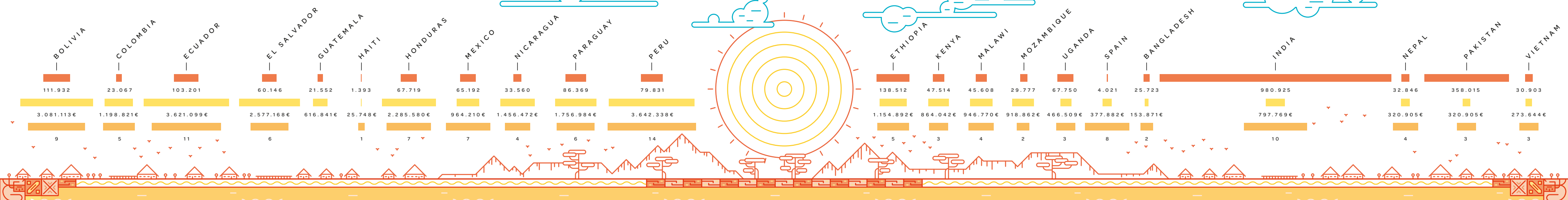
